## UNAUTHORISED ADDITIONS AND ALTERATIONS: Erf 662, being at 14/20 Clair Avenue, Cato Manor, Durban.

We acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to carry out work on the above property. The KZN Amafa and Research Institute (the Institute) reviewed the application on the 16 November 2022.

Please be advised as follows: -

(1) The Institute was unable to consider the merits of the application as the work had already commenced, alternatively, has been completed;

(2) As a result, a permit cannot now be issued;

(3) We would like to draw your attention to the fact that your failure to obtain a permit prior to the commencement of the work, is in contravention of the provisions of the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute Act (5 of 2018), and as such is a criminal offence for which you may be prosecuted;

(4) However, the Institute has decided to condone your failure to obtain a permit, as required, on condition that the work was conducted strictly in accordance with **drawing number 6702/22/1, 2 & 3,** dated September 2022, drawn by M.R Azmuth (Graham Braum Architectural Designer), received

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by the Institute on the 11 October 2022, and that all the work shown on the application is completed within a calendar year of the date of this letter.

- (5) Prior written approval from the Institute is required for any deviation to the approved plans.
- (6) No legal action will be instituted against you in this instance.
