The SAHRA APM Unit does not accept the Phase 1 Heritage Impact Assessment conducted by L. Marais-Botes on the following grounds:

- The track of the field survey does not enter the actual development area but rather follows the roads and area surrounding the development area (compare Figures 2 and 3). Any heritage resources within the latter area were therefore not sufficiently inspected.

- A map, in which all heritage resources (palaeontological and archaeological) are clearly marked, must be provided. This map should include the exact locations of building structures photographed and illustrated in Figures 6, 7, 12, 13 and 14.

- A field study for palaeontological heritage resources, done by a professional and suitably accredited palaeontologist (see list on the website of the Palaeontological Society of Southern Africa <u>www.palaeontologicalsociety.org.za</u>) must be included as this area falls within an area of very high palaeontological sensitivity according o the PalaeoSensitivity Map on SAHRIS (<u>http://sahra.org.za/map/palaeo</u>).

Therefore the SAHRA APM Unit continues to request Phase 1 Heritage Impact Assessment to be submitted before comments can be released on the development. Please note the HIA must contain a field study Palaeontological Impact Assessment.
