Letter

In terms of Section 35(3) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)

For Attention: Exigo Sustainability (Pty) Ltd

Dear Applicant,

The SAHRA Development Applications Unit (DAU) has reviewed the permit report submitted to this case and has accepted the following recommendations:

- The project Chance Find Procedure (CFP) should be observed at all times during construction and operational phases of the project.
- All employees, contractors, sub-contractors and visitors should undergo heritage induction and training. In addition, prior to the commencement of the Bolubedu Project the Site EO as primary, in contact with project ECO & Voltalia Environmental Specialist must receive training on this CFP, including a working overview of the cultural heritage landscape, sensitivities and mitigation measures required for implementation.

However, the following recommendation is not sufficient:

Considering the localised nature of heritage remains, the general monitoring of the development progress by an ECO or by the heritage specialist is recommended for all stages of the project.

The SAHRA DAU requires the monitoring by a heritage specialist during the initial excavations in the areas around EXIGO-BSP-IA03, EXIGO-BSP-IA04, EXIGO-BSP-IA05 and EXIGO-BSP-IA07. A monitoring report must be submitted upon the completion of the construction phase in these areas.

Once the monitoring report is submitted, and no cultural material is identified in these areas, after SAHRA has approved the monitoring report, then the CFP can be undertaken by the ECO.
