### **Interim Comment**

### In terms of Section 38(3) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)

Kuhlula Jeff Maluleke was appointed by PRO Give Enteprises (Pty) Ltd to undertake a Basic Assessment (BA) Process in support of the Environment Authorisation (EA) Application for a mining permit application on portion of the farm Ontevreden 838 KS, Fetakgomo Tubatse Local Municipality, Limpopo Province.

A Draft Basic Assessment Report (DBAR) and Environmental Management Programme Report (EMPR) has been submitted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA) and the EIA Regulations for activities that trigger the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (MPRDA)(As amended). The applicant proposes to mine for building sand. The proposed mining of such minerals will be conducted through excavation. The mined minerals will be transported to an external site for storage and pilling. The project will involve excavation, which will be done using a TLB and an excavator. The application for a mining permit will involve a pits and trenches which will be anticipated on site.

No heritage report has been uploaded on this application.


