- 7. KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute shall not be liable for any loss, damage or injuries to any person/s or property caused by any of the activities conducted by the applicant;
- 8. All archaeological and paleontological Material become, on discovery, the property of the Province of KwaZulu-Natal and must be lodged at the repository of KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute.
- 9. It is the responsibility of the Applicant to ensure that artefacts are preserved in its original state while in his/her possession;
- 10. The Applicant shall be liable for any damage or destruction caused at any site or to any artefact.
